## **Report on Cyber Crime Awareness Programme**

**Date of Event:** 6th March, 2019

**Organized by:** Sarat Centenary College (Special Camp by NSS UNIT -I, II & III)

**Number of Participants:** 65

**Event Overview:** On 6th February 2023, Sarat Centenary College, through its National Service Scheme (NSS) unit, conducted a Cyber Crime Awareness Programme. This special camp was aimed at educating participants about the various forms of cybercrime, preventive measures, and safe online practices.
