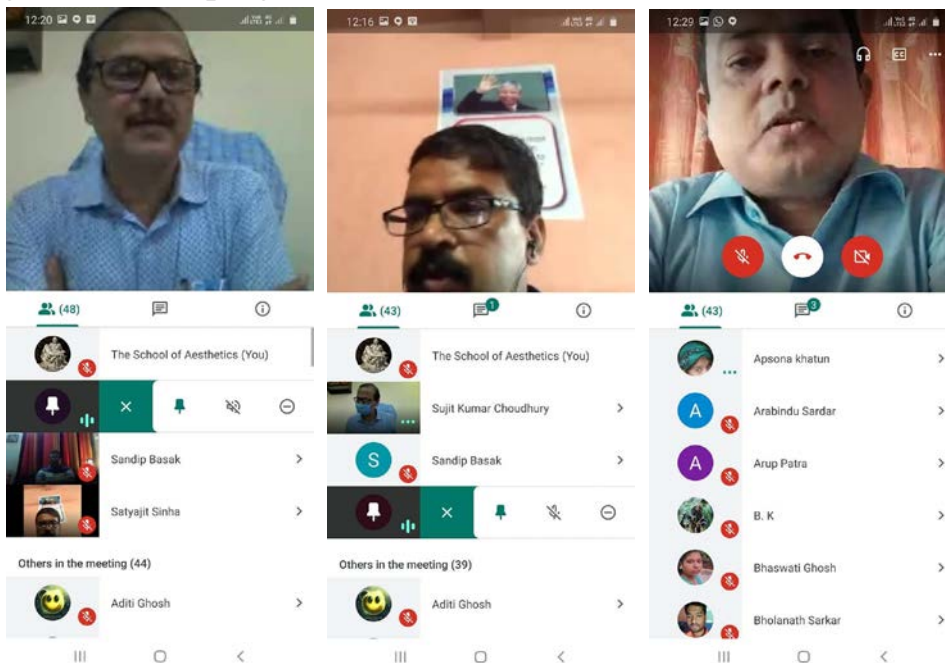

19. 74th Independence Day was celebrated in our college premises at 8.00 am by our NSS Volunteers, Program Officers, Office staff on 15th August, 2020.



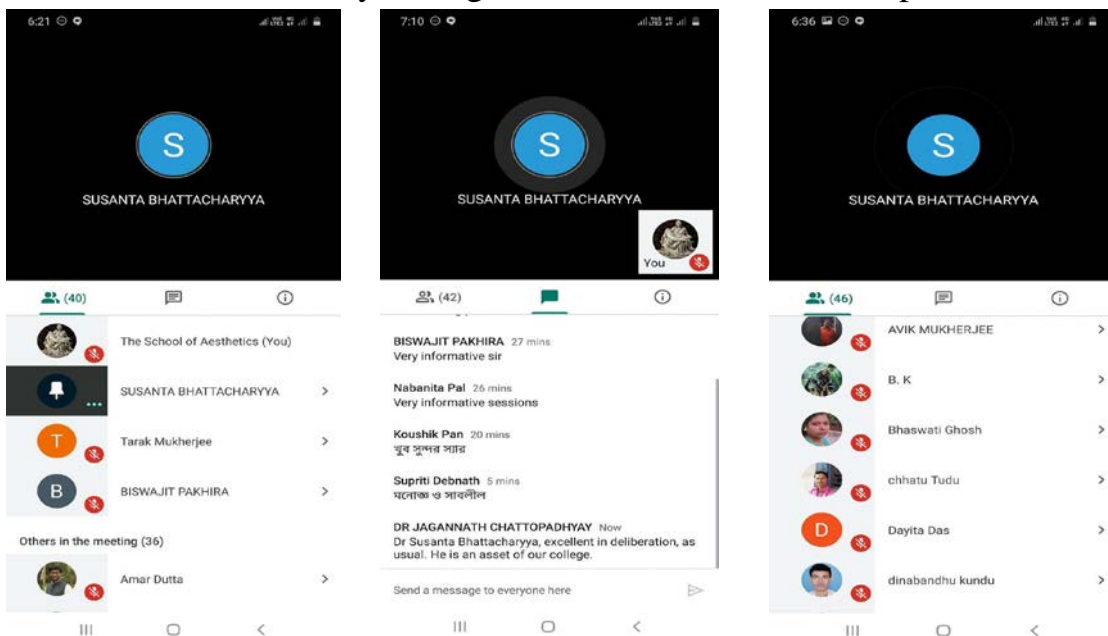

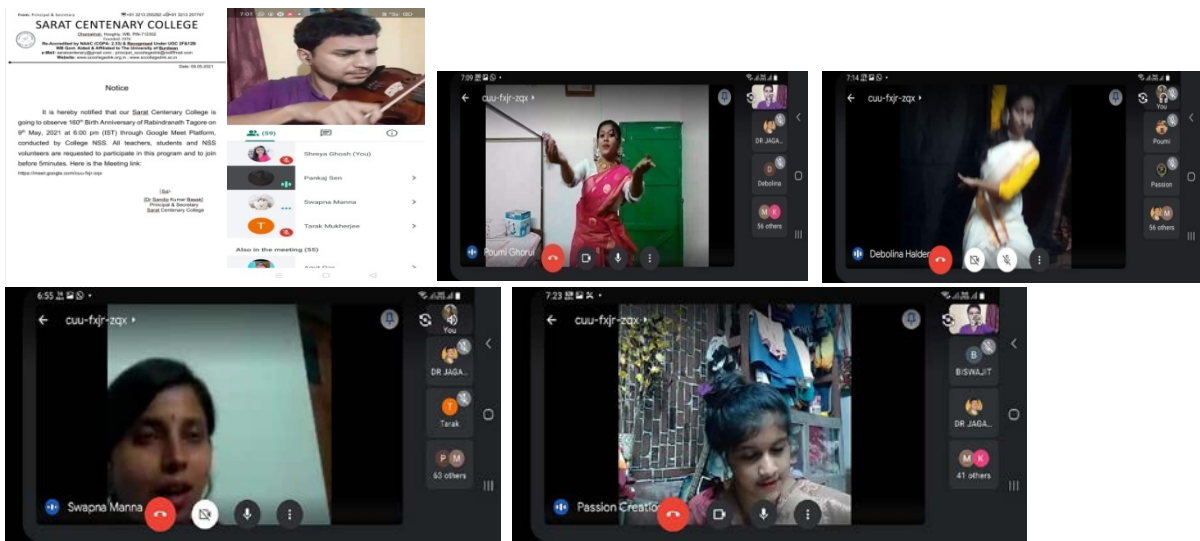
Bhattacharya, Associate Professor in Political Science delivered a speech on this said topic. Almost 30 students were present in the webinar.



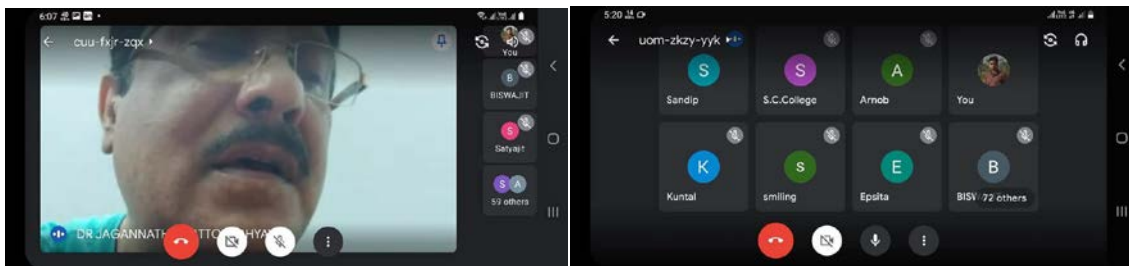

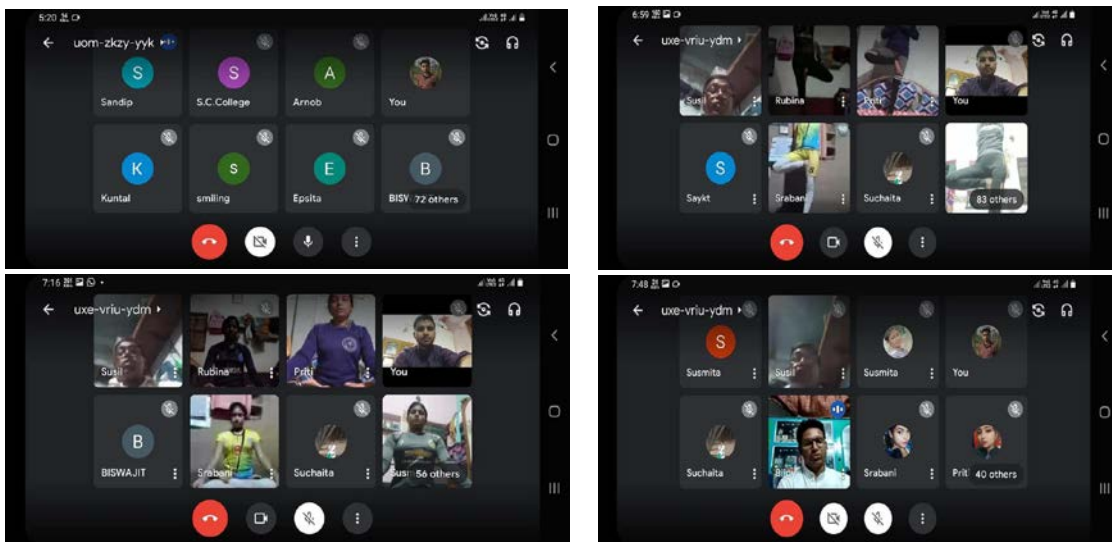

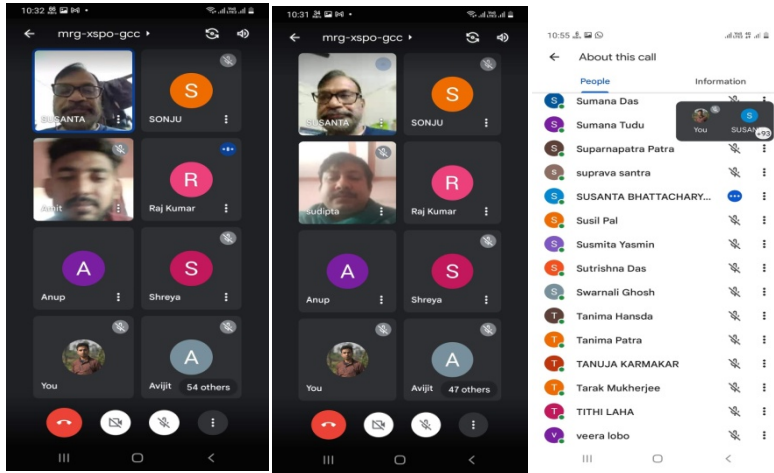
