## Notification for admission to Post Graduate Courses for the session 2020-21

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates of Honours Graduates of both CBCS and (1+1+1) pattern who passed out 2019 and 2020 and Graduates of Programme Courses of CBCS of passing year 2020 only for admission to the following regular full time PG Courses (duration- 2 years or 4 Semesters) for the session 2020-2021.

For newly introduced Professional courses (M.B.A, Master in Computer Science, Master in Journalism And Mass Communication), there is no restriction on year of passing of UG course. A candidate having requisite qualification may apply for admission to the Professional courses irrespective of the year of passing of the qualifying examination.

• A candidate may apply for maximum three courses.

Any candidate already applied for / admitted in general PG course may also apply for the professional courses. In such case there shall be no bar for application for more than three subjects. However no Student will be permitted to take admission in two courses in the same academic year.

## **Eligibility:**

- (i) 80% seats will be for the Honours Graduates of Home University with 03 year Honours in relevant subject who have completed their graduation in the year 2019 & 2020.
- (ii) 20% seats will be for the:
  - (a) Honours Graduates of Other Universities with 03 year Honours/major in relevant subject who have completed their graduation in the year 2019 & 2020.
  - (b) The Programme Course student passed in 2020 with at least 60% in aggregate may apply for PG course in his/her Discipline 1
  - (c) Students of SKBU who did not get chance of admission in 80% category are eligible to be considered in 20% category also.

**M.A in Anthropology & Tribal Studies** – 03 year Honours Graduates / Programme Graduates (CBCS) having any of the following subjects as Discipline 1 in Anthropology, Botany, Economics ,Geography, History , Philosophy, Political Science, Sociology, Zoology may also apply.

**M.A in Sociology:** 03 year Honours Graduates / Programme Graduates (CBCS) having any of the following subjects as Discipline 1 in Sociology, Anthropology, Economics, History, Philosophy, Political Science may also apply.

**M.A in Economics:** 03 year Honours Graduates / Programme Graduates (CBCS) having any of the following subjects as Discipline 1 in Economics, Mathematics & Statistics may also apply.

**M.A in Journalism and Mass Communication:** Honours Graduate in any discipline / Programme Graduates (CBCS).

**M.Sc. in Computer Science:** (i) B.Sc. in Computer Science Honours or (ii) B.Sc. Programme Graduates (CBCS) with Computer Science and Mathematics or (iii) BCA.

#### **Master in Business Administration (MBA):**

- A Bachelor Degree (under 10+2+3 system) in Arts/ Science/ Commerce [(Honours/ Programme (CBCS)]
- A Bachelor Degree (under 10+2+4 system) in Engineering and Technology/ Medical Science/ Law/ Professional Course or its equivalent from any recognized University
- A Bachelor degree (under 10+2+3 system) in Business Administration (BBA).

**M.A./ M.Sc. of OTHER** courses: Graduates with Honours /Major in the subject of study (CBCS and 1+1+1 pattern) / Programme Graduates (CBCS) may apply for PG course in his/her Discipline 1.

- Note for the Professional Courses (M.A in Journalism and Mass Communication.

  M.Sc. in Computer Science and Master in Business Administration):
- 1. Any candidate already applied for / admitted in general PG course may also apply for the professional courses. In such case there shall be **no bar for application for more than three subjects**.
- 2. For above mentioned Professional courses there is **no restriction on year of passing of UG course**.
  - A candidate having requisite qualification may apply for admission to the Professional courses irrespective of the year of passing the qualifying examination.
- 3. **Only the qualifying degree** irrespective of the year of passing of the respective qualifying examination to achieve the degree will be considered as eligibility to apply for admission to the professional courses.

#### **Course fees for Professional Courses:**

- M. Sc. Computer Science: Rs. 20,000/- per Semester
- M.A Journalism & Mass Communication: Rs. 20,000/- per Semester
- Master in Business Administration M.B.A: Rs.20,000/-per Semester

Mode of Payment is online only through Payment Gateway in the admission portal by Debit/Credit card and Net Banking. Candidates are not to come to the University counter for any payment.

## **Selection Process/ Process of Merit list framing:**

- (i) 80% Category: Selection will be made strictly in order of merit by taking into the consideration of **Aggregate Percentage** only.
- (ii) 20% Category: There will be no Entrance Test for this year. Selection will be made in order of merit by taking into the consideration of **Aggregate Percentage** only.
- (iii) For the Honours Candidate of (1+1+1) pattern, **Percentage of Marks obtained in Honours subject** will be considered.

(iv) Both for the Honours and Program course candidates of CBCS Curriculum, the CGPA secured will be considered.

CGPA will be converted to percentage by multiplying it by 10 for the students of SKBU. For other Universities instructions given in the Grade Card by the Universities will be followed. If no instruction/formula is available, the standard procedure will be adopted.

## In case of tie, following will be considered.

- a) The marks (percentage of best four subjects) of HS (10+2) will be considered.
- b) If again tie occurs then the Aggregate Percentage of Madhyamik (10<sup>th</sup> level) will be considered.
- c) If still tie remains Aggregate Percentage of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> language subjects obtained in H.S (10+2) will be considered.

<u>Note:</u> (i) During filling up the Form for admission if any candidate applies for admission in Nistarini College or JK College as the first preference and the candidate gets chance for admission in the college of first preference the candidate will be admitted there. After admission there the candidate will not be upgraded for admission to SKBU even when seats fall vacant in SKBU.

(ii) Any candidate if applies for admission in SKBU as the first preference, but got admission in Nistarini College or JK College, in later time the candidate may be upgraded to SKBU after fulfillment of all terms and conditions.

#### **Verification of Documents:**

- Verification of all original documents will be made at the time of commencement of 1<sup>st</sup> semester class.
- If any candidate fails to produce her/his all original documents at the time of verification, her/his candidature will be cancelled.

All originals and one set of attested photocopies of following Documents are required to be produced at the time of commencement of class:

- ID card, issued by Govt. authority
- Proof of age: Admit or Certificate of Madhyamik or equivalent examination
- All Undergraduate Mark-sheets.
- Certificate of Reserve category (if applicable): SC/ST/OBC/PH certificate issued by Govt. authority,
- Person With Disability Certificate (if applicable): PWD (minimum 40% disability) certificate issued by Govt. authority
- Certificates of Sports Persons (only State/National Level Tournament participation certificate will be considered).

#### Note:

- 1) The admission process will be entirely online and according to the merit. Prospective Students will not to be called for counseling or verification of documents during the admission process. No physical presence will be required at University campus.
- 2) Admission Regulation of the University and Reservation Policy as per Government Rules are to be followed.
- 3) The candidate who is eligible for admission will be informed directly in a suitable way by the authority.
- 4) Payment of Fees shall be done only through e-payment or designated Banks and not to be deposited physically at University Campus.
- 5) All testimonials are required to be uploaded online during application. Verification of documents, if required, will be done only when the students report for the classes in due course. Proper action will be taken if any discrepancy is found.
- 6) For any payment related issue / other query, please contact with HELP DESK No: 9002584311.
- 7) All PG courses at SKBU are full-time regular courses. In-service candidates are not allowed to pursue the courses.
- 8) The admitted students are required to maintain 75% attendance positively throughout all the semesters. If any student is found with attendance below 75% at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> month, his/her admission will be cancelled automatically.
- 9) All stakeholders shall adhere to the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Government time to time.
