Some Important points for SEM-III & SEM- V students (Academic Session:2022-23)

It is already notified that offline classes for B.A., B.Sc, B.Com Honours and General Courses will begin w.e.f 1st August, 2022. Students are advised to note the following important points about the CBCS curriculum:

- A student from Honours course (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.) shall have to study two SEC papers (one each in Sem-III and Sem-IV) from their <u>respective Honours subject only</u>.
- ➤ A student of BA General (CBCS) course need to study 4 SEC papers (two each form the chosen two core subjects).
- ➤ In case of B.Com. Gen. Course, a student shall have to study 04 Skill Enhancement Courses as specified in the relevant curriculum.
- > Credit of a SEC paper is 2. Full marks of a SEC paper is 50. 10 marks for class test/assignment/seminar and 40 marks for Semester end exam.
