

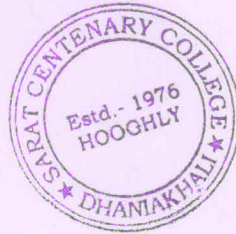
1. Write a critical appreciation of Sonnet 116 by William Shakespeare.
