OUR COLLEGE: A LOOK BACK



Sarat Centenary College, situated at Dhaniakhali, is a West Bengal Government aided college, accredited by NAAC. The college was established as a junior college in 1976, the year which marked the birth centenary of the great Bengali novelist Sarat Chandra Chattopadhyay, and was later upgraded

to a degree college in 1978 with Arts, Science, and Commerce streams affiliated by The University of Burdwan.

VISION, MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

Dhaniakhali assembly constituency, reserved for SC category, is comprised of population mostly from economically weaker section of the society, specifically SC, ST, OBC, and Minority communities. As the only institute of higher learning in the undergraduate level in the Dhaniakhali Development Block, there is a need to develop a network and strong covalent linkage with the society. The college encourages and spreads knowledge and value-based education amongst the young mind and thereby enlighten them to build the career in personal and professional life with an emphasis of all-round development in respect to the global scenario. LOCATION

The College is situated in Dhaniakhali Development Block (22.96° N 88.10° E) in the district of Hooghly just beside the Chinsurah-Tarakeswar road which links the college to Chinsurah and Tarakeswar. Dhaniakhali Halt (DNHL) railway station on Howrah-Burdwan Chord railway line is just 5 kilometres away from this college and this railway connects the college with Howrah and Burdwan. The NH2 expressway is just 10 kilometres from the college. The place is approximately 50 kilometres away from Kolkata.



BASIC REQUIREMENTS, GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO 1ST YEAR OF 4 YEAR HONOURS & 3 YEAR DEGREE COURSES:

- 1. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination in 2022/2023/2024/2025 can apply online. For studyingin 4 Year Degree Course with Honours in any subject a candidate is required to secure 45% marks in the H.S. Examination or equivalent (10+2) examination in the concerned year.Rules/ guidelines issued by the affiliating University/ State Government /UGC regarding admission, reservation, remittance and refund of fees shall be strictly followed.
- 2. For admission visit centralised admission portal https://wbcap.in/ and follow the guideline mentioned in the portal.
- 3. Physical verification of documents of the candidate will be done at the college after taking admission at the end of the concerned phase. Candidates who will take provisional admission through the centralised admission portal will report to the college within the notified schedule for physical verification of documents. They must carry printed copies of their provisional admission slip and all academic and other relevant documents in original. If, during the physical verification of documents at the college, it is found that there is a discrepancy between the data provided in the portal and that found in the documents, which may have had an impact on eligibility and/or Merit Rank / Position, the provisional admission may be summarily cancelled. Admission will be finally confirmed only after successful verification of all relevant documents by the college, followed by registration with the affiliated university.

Candidates must carry the following documents in original and one self-attested copy of each.

- Class 10th Standard mark sheet.
- Class 10th Standard Examination Admit Card (Age Proof)
- Class 10+2 Standard mark sheet, Admit Card and Registration Certificate
- Social category certificate (if applicable)
- Disability certificate (if applicable)
- Valid Photo ID Proof as submitted in the application form
- Aadhar Card (Preferably)
- System Generated Provisional Admission Slip

As a result of document verification -If a candidate is found not eligible for any course / programme because of any discrepancy in data and/or document (which may have an adverse impact on the merit index of the candidate), the provisional admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND CAMPUS LIFE

The college always keeps open its eyes to the needs of the students and accordingly provides proper infrastructural and other support.

Class rooms: The classrooms are specious and airy with proper ventilation and are equipped with adequate lights, fans, chairs, tables, benches, and boards.

Library: The library building comprises of three rooms with sufficient light and space. The system is now fully computerized. The library contains nearly 22000 books, journals and magazines. Besides this the Library has access to Inflibnet facility through which students can access 1,99,536 + e-books and 6,150+ e-journals. Bengali and English daily newspapers, job oriented news papersand bulletins like Karmakhetra, Karmasansthan, Achivers etc. are also available in the library. Syllabi, university question papers are also available. There is a separate reading room for the students in the library. The number of books increases every year. The institute is interested to link-up with the repository and information system at global scenario thorough internet facility.

Laboratories: The college has separate well equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Geographyfor practical classes. There is a Computer lab for skill oriented courses also. Laboratories are clean, airy with adequate space and infrastructure and safety measures to conduct the practical classes smoothly.

ICT facilities: There are two smart class rooms inside the campus with overhead LCD projectors, computers, wi-fi connection, and interactive board. Besides these there are portable projectors and laptops that are used in other class rooms too. Students can access INFLIBNET contents and subject/career related websites in library and in some departments.

Common Rooms: There are separate common rooms for boys and girls with adequate infrastructural arrangements and indoor game facilities to enjoy their leisure period.

Parking Shed: Parking shed is present inside the campus for keeping bicycles, motor bikes etc.

Auditorium: A fully air-conditioned sophisticated auditorium is available with all modern facilities like multimedia projector, indoor public address system and other ICT facilities. Cultural programmes, seminars, symposia, work-shops, debates etc. are arranged in the auditorium at regular interval.

Gymnasium and Yoga Centre: Considering the physical and mental fitness of the students, a well equipped multi-gym has been runningunder the supervision of the Physical Education Department.

The following rules and regulations are maintained for smooth running of gymnasium: Gym Hours: 10.30 am to 12.30 pm for female students; 1.00 pm to 4.00 pm for male students.

Playground: A large playground is present inside the campus premises for games and sports events like football, cricket, volleyball etc.

Landscape & Biodiversity: The clean and green campus, enriched with flora and fauna add to the beauty of landscape of the premises. There is a small waterbody inside the campus that harbours many aquatic life forms. There is also a century-old tamarind tree inside the

campus. There is a small garden in the college with rare medicinal and aromatic plants. The purpose of this herbal garden is to conserve the potent native germplasm to educate the students.

Drinking water: Drinking water with water cooler is available in the campus. In this regard, 'Pather Panchali' – a drinking water facility of Dhaniakhali Panchayet Samiti is also available.

STUDENT SUPPORT SYSTEM

The college has a dedicated student support system to provide assistance and facilities to the students which are as follows:

Free studentship: Free studentship is provided to the needy students on the basis of merit and attendance. The application should reach to the Principal within stipulated time notified in the notice board in this regard.

Poor Fund: Assistance in the banner of poor fund is also provided for the eligible students on the basis of their application invited through notification in due time.

Scholarships: The institute always extends help to the students to avail various types of scholarship as and when available from Government and other authorities like B.C.W Department, Labour Welfare Department, WBMDFC, Jindal etc. The college also helps the students for various kinds of assistance like Kanyashree etc. A large number of students of our college are benefitted from such scholarships.

Remedial coaching classes:Remedial coaching classes/Mentoring Classes are held for the Students.

Career Counselling Cell: The Career Counselling Cell of the college has been established to encourage and to provide information to the students including former students about the present job scenario, self-employment, entrepreneurship development and other issues related to career development.

Continuous Assessment System & Examination: There is a process of continuous assessment of students through various kinds of examinations like surprise tests, unit tests, project writing and other test at regular interval. Before the starting of new academic session, college prepares the academic calendar for the upcoming session mentioning list of holidays, academic programmes, important days of observation etc and the academic calendar are displayed in the college notice board and in the college website.

Community Development by NSS: As the college is a part of society, so, there are some responsibilities towards the society which are carried out through community development and extension activities. Three NSS units headed by Prof. Pankaj Sen, Prof.Biswajit Pakhira and Prof. Sunetra Banerjee organise several programmes like blood donation, health camp, flood relief, awareness programmes for AIDS, Polio, Hepatitis, Plantation, Special Camps and many others throughout the year.

Students' Council: Students' Council is the platform to raise the issues on various subjects related to students. The election of Students' Council is held following norms and regulations framed by the university and the State Government.

Identity Card: Identity Card of each student is supplied by the college authority. Each student should enter in the college with valid Identity Card.

Research and Consultancy Activities: There is a Research and Consultancy Cell in the college to carry out research and consultancy works. The departmental field and survey projects are supervised by this cell.

Some of the faculty members are also engaged in various international/central/state funded research projects for building a strong research atmosphere in the college.

Moreover, the departments of Botany, Zoology and Geography organise such excursion as per module of syllabus.

Women Empowerment: The Women's Study Cell of the college is running various kinds of activities related to women empowerment, gender sensitization, and social justice for women. The cell organizes several programmes in this regard.

Integrational Aspect: The college encourages the national ethos of integration among caste, creed and religion through 'Dalit Studies Cell'. Dhaniakhali is the reserved constituency. CODES OF CONDUCT

About Us

"It was the ardent zeal for advancement of higher education that the people of Dhaniakhali to establish Sarat Centenary College, named after one of the greatest Bengali novelists, Sarat Chandra Chattopadhyay, in 1976 as a Junior College with the Higher Secondary Course which was later upgraded into a Degree College in 1978 with all the three streams Arts, Science and Commerce being affiliated under the University of Burdwan. The college stands at the heart of Dhaniakhali. It is under grants-in-aid Scheme of the Government of West Bengal. The College campus extends over an area of 03 acres.

The college provides Honours in Bengali, Sanskrit, English, Political Science, Philosophy, History, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Accountancy. General courses offered by the college are Bengali, Sanskrit, Santali, English, Political Science, Philosophy, Education, History, Geography, Physical Education, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Commerce. Some vocational courses like Communicative English, Computer Basics, Tailoring-Knitting etc. have been introduced from the session 2015-2016. Further, few Add-on Certificate courses, say, Proof reading in English, Basics of Computer Application, Spoken Sanskrit and Digital Photography Basics, etc. have been introduced from the session 2024-2025. Furthermore, a Women Study Centre is functioning with the task of awareness about Gender Biases.

Presently, a sufficient number of Associate Professors, Assistant professors, Government Approved Part-Time Teachers and Guest Lecturers are catering academic needs of all the three streams. The standard of education and academic results are good and encouraging. The students evaluate the teaching standard of the departments as per the university norms. A good number of teachers have national and international linkage through their academic activities. A sufficient number of academic support staff of the college, including part-time and contractual staff, are rendering their service.

The college regularly organizes seminars, inter-departmental talks, debates, quizzes and other academic ventures. The college has started remedial courses for the benefit of the -students both socially and academically backwards. The Principal and the Governing Body monitor all the developmental works.

Besides the main building, the college has a separate library building (Netaji Bhawan), which has about 22083 books and various journals. The Jagadish Chandra Bose Bhawan, Vidyasagar Bhawan, U.G.C. Building, have provided more classrooms to meet the growing demands. A new building for Students' Union, Cheap Canteen and Boys' Common Room is at the point of completion. The main building encompasses a good garden along with Ayruvedic Plants. The laboratories are relatively well-equipped. Microphone systems are available in Classrooms where it is necessary. Twelve (12) smart classrooms or ICT (Information and Communication Technology) facility classrooms, eight smart TV system class rooms exist in our college. For student security we have installed 48 CCTVs in our college campus. Construction under MPLADS has added extra classrooms to this college.

The college has a spacious playground and a pond surrounded by the shady green trees. The NSS adds much to the progress in the academic atmosphere of the college. It is worth mentioning that the NSS has already imprinted its valuable marks for the total development of the college. Two AC Computer Labs, One Gymnasium with AC and a well-equipped Yoga Center are in operative mode. Further, all computer of these two labs is powered by Solar Panels.. More land is yet to be purchased. Moreover, the college has already approached the high authorities for introducing job-oriented new courses. Apart from academic development, the college is keen on the all-round development of the students. Regular counselling by the teachers is offered to the students for guidance towards an exact route for their establishment in multifarious segments of life. The college has already left its mark of success in different spheres. The 3rd cycle accreditation by NAAC has been completed in January 2025, B+ (CGPA – 2.63)."


Example: How to Search by District




Example: How to Search by Programme
